This is a summary of the annual report of the THOR INDUSTRIES, INC. WELFARE BENEFIT PLAN, EIN 93-0768752, Plan No. 530, for period 01/01/2021 through 12/31/2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

THOR INDUSTRIES, INC. has committed itself to pay certain self-funded Medical claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with ZURICH AMERICAN INSURANCE COMPANY, CONTINENTAL AMERICAN INSURANCE COMPANY, VISION SERVICE PLAN, UNITEDHEALTHCARE INSURANCE COMPANY, METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY. TRUSTMARK INSURANCE COMPANY and DELTA DENTAL OF INDIANA to pay Medical, Dental, Vision, Life Insurance, Short-term Disability, Long-term Disability, Accidental Death and Dismemberment, and Business Travel Accident claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021 were \$12,743,552.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2021, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$4,954,948 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$4,457,583.

This is a summary of the annual report for Thor Industries, Inc. 401(k) Plan, Employer Identification Number 93-0768752, Plan No. 001 for the period January 01, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided through insurance and through a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$10,832,513. These expenses included \$114,258 in administrative expenses and \$10,686,377 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries and \$31,878 in other expenses. A total of 13514 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$114,426,734, as of December 31, 2021 compared to \$97,038,487 as of January 01, 2021. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$17,388,247. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$28,220,760, including employer contributions of \$1,814,723, employee contributions of \$10,274,399, other contributions of \$1,519,914, and earnings from investments of \$14,611,724.
